Registration & Payment Steps

- 1. Complete the online registration form.
- 2. If you received scholarships, indicate the types and amounts on your registration form. Your total amount due will be reduced by that amount. NOTE: The camp registrar reviews and confirms all scholarships claimed. If a scholarship is not confirmed, you will receive an updated invoice for the amount due.
- 3. Click the "Next" button at the bottom of the form.
- 4. Review your information on the "Confirm Your Entry" page. If it is correct, click the "Submit" button at the bottom of the page. A confirmation email is sent to both the student and parent addresses.
- 5. The camper is now registered!

- 6. On the "Submission Details" page, click the "Checkout" button. This leads to the payment page for credit/debit card payment. Visa, MasterCard, Discover, and American Express are accepted.
- 7. A payment confirmation email is sent to both the parent and student addresses.
- 8. If payment is not made, you are still registered. We will follow up by email regarding the balance due.
- 9. Jr. High Band Camp fees must be paid in full by June 17.

Sr. High Band and Jr./Sr. High Orchestra Camp fees must be paid in full by June 24.

Refunds are paid only to the original payer of fees and may take up to three weeks to process. No refunds are made for campers asked to leave camp due to rules violations.

Scholarships

There are many opportunities for students to receive scholarship help to attend U of A Summer Music Camps.

No scholarships are available by direct application to camp, only through school music programs.

Captain Selection

Captains are selected each year from students attending Music Camp, using a process that involves input from the students' hometown teacher(s), Music Camp conductors, counselors, and section rehearsal/master class/elective teachers. Students who attended 2023 camp and were designated as 2024 Captains will receive a \$245 scholarship for 2024 camp. Captain scholarships are not transferrable to other students.

Outstanding Musician Awards

Students selected as Outstanding Musician for the Symphony Orchestra, Sr. High Honor Band or Jr. High Honor Band, receive a full tuition scholarship in the amount of \$495 to camp for the next year. Students selected as Outstanding Musician for any other Music Camp large ensemble (band or orchestra) receive a \$245 scholarship to camp for the next year. Students who attended 2023 camp and were awarded musician awards may apply them to 2024 fees. Outstanding Musician awards are not transferrable to other students.

Hometown Scholarships

Many school music programs provide scholarships for their students to attend camp; the booster club or other parent/supporter organization in each town often sponsors these scholarships. Distribution of these scholarship awards is at the discretion of the school's band/orchestra directors.

Named Scholarships

The Janzen-Tollette Scholarship is a needs and merit-based scholarship named in honor of University of Arkansas Director of Bands Emeritus Eldon A. Janzen, his wife Nel, and former Razorback Marching Band Drum Major Sanford Tollette. These scholarships are awarded through qualifying schools' music directors.

All-State Scholarships

Students selected in their state's top All-State band or orchestra are eligible to receive a \$100 scholarship toward the price of camp during the year of their selection. In Arkansas, this includes students who participate in Orchestra and Wind Symphony. In Oklahoma, students in Wind Ensemble, Symphonic Band, and Orchestra are eligible for the All-State Scholarship. Alternates for these ensembles are not eligible for the scholarship.

Combining Scholarships

Scholarships awarded by U of A Summer Music Camp (Captain Scholarships, Outstanding Musician Awards, Named Scholarships, All State Scholarships) or by hometown music programs may be combined, up to the amount of tuition.
